

LICENCE TO PUBLISH

In this Agreement the following words and expressions shall have the meaning set out opposite them:

"Authors" means [insert the name and addresses of all the authors];

"Contribution" means the article currently entitled [insert title] (manuscript number: [insert]);

"Journal" means the British Journal of Pharmacology;

"Material" means the Contribution and the Supplementary Information;

"BPS" means The British Pharmacological Society;

"Publication Fee" means the BJP Open fee of \$2,500 / 1,800 euros / £1,250 + VAT; and

"the Supplementary Information" means any other written information provided by the Authors to the Society in connection with or that relates to the Contribution (including, but not limited to, protocols and methods).

1. In consideration of the BPS agreeing to publish the Contribution in the Journal the Authors grant to the BPS for the full term of copyright in the Contribution and any extensions thereto, subject to clauses 2, 3 and 4 below, the exclusive licence (a) to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the Contribution in all forms, formats and media whether now known or hereafter developed (including without limitation in print, digital and electronic form) throughout the world, (b) to translate the Contribution into other languages, create adaptations, summaries or extracts of the Contribution or other derivative works based on the Contribution and exercise all of the rights set forth in (a) above in such translations, adaptations, summaries, extracts and derivative works and (c) to license others to do any or all of the above.
 - a) To reproduce the Contribution in whole or in part in any printed volume (book or thesis) of which they are the author(s).
 - b) They and any academic institution where they work at the time may reproduce the Contribution for the purpose of course teaching.
 - c) To post a copy of the Contribution as accepted for publication after peer review (in Word or Text format) on the Authors' own web site or institutional repository or the Authors' funding body's archive six months after publication of the printed or online edition of the Journal, provided that they also give a hyperlink from the Contribution to the Journal's web site
 - d) To reuse figures or tables created by them and contained in the Contribution in other works created by them.
2. Ownership of copyright remains with the Authors, and even if the publication fee is not paid, the authors retain the following non-exclusive rights provided that, when reproducing the Contribution or extracts from it, the Authors acknowledge first and reference publication in the Journal:
 - a) whenever the Contribution is reproduced (in whole or in part) the original authorship is fully attributed and the Journal is cited as the original place of publications, with full citation;
 - b) any derivative works based on the Contribution are clearly identified as being based on the contribution and clearly cite the journal as the original place of publication of the contribution with full citation; and
 - c) the Contribution is only reproduced or otherwise used for educational and research purpose and not for any direct or indirect commercial purpose.
3. For authors choosing *BJP Open*, on receipt of the Publication Fee by the BPS it is hereby agreed that the licence granted in clause 1 above shall be deemed to have been granted on a non-exclusive basis, provided that the Authors ensure that:
 - a) whenever the Contribution is reproduced (in whole or in part) the original authorship is fully attributed and the Journal is cited as the original place of publications, with full citation;
 - b) any derivative works based on the Contribution are clearly identified as being based on the contribution and clearly cite the journal as the original place of publication of the contribution with full citation; and
 - c) the Contribution is only reproduced or otherwise used for educational and research purpose and not for any direct or indirect commercial purpose.
4. In consideration of the BPS agreeing to publish the Contribution, the Authors also grant to the BPS for the full term of copyright and any extensions thereto the same rights, that have either been granted in respect of the Contribution as set out in clause 1 above, or deemed to have been granted pursuant to clause 3 (as the case may be), in the Supplementary Information but on a non-exclusive basis.
5. The Authors warrant and represent that:
 - a) The Authors are the sole authors of and sole owners of the copyright in the Material. If the Material includes materials of others, the Authors have obtained the permission of the owners of the copyright in all such materials to enable them to grant the rights contained herein. Copies of all such permissions are attached to this licence.

- b) All of the facts contained in the Material are true and accurate.
- c) The Author who has signed this Agreement below has full right, power and authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of all of the Authors.
- d) Nothing in the Material is obscene, defamatory, libelous, violates any right of privacy or infringes any intellectual property rights (including without limitation copyright, patent or trademark) or any other human, personal or other rights of any person or entity or is otherwise unlawful.
- e) Nothing in the Material infringes any duty of confidentiality which any of the Authors may owe to anyone else or violates any contract, express

or implied, of any of the Authors, and all of the institutions in which work recorded in the Material was carried out have authorised publication of the Material.

- 6. The Authors authorise the BPS to take such steps as it considers necessary at its own expense in the Authors' name and on their behalf if it believes that a third party is infringing or is likely to infringe copyright in the Contribution.
- 7. The Authors hereby consent to the inclusion of electronic links from the Material to third-party material wherever it may be located.
- 8. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England without regard to the principles of conflicts of law. The parties hereto submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
